

MUSEUM OF LIVERPOOL

Few cities can match Liverpool for its wealth of history. The Museum of Liverpool reflects the city's global significance through its unique geography, history and culture. Visitors can explore how the port, its people and their creative and sporting history have shaped the city. The museum opened on 19 July 2011 in a landmark building on the waterfront and has won several awards, including the Council of Europe Museum Prize for 2013. Its collections cover Social History, The Overhead Railway which closed 60 years ago and, of course, The Beatles. There really is something for all the family at this fascinating venue.

The World Museum is one of Britain's greatest museums, with varied collections and displays focused on life sciences, earth sciences and human cultures from around the world. The ever-popular Dinosaurs and Ancient Egypt sections sit alongside a Planetarium and Space and Time attraction. Children will love looking at the fish in the aquarium, watching films and live performances in the theatre, taking a journey through space in the planetarium and examining creepy crawlies in the bug house.

Described as 'Liverpool's fullest, funniest day out', Imagine That caters to babies and children up to age 12. Five sections offer morning or afternoon visits. The Science Area provides an interactive introduction to the world of science, while budding engineers can muck in at The Construction Area. A highlight of the Art Area is the paint the car section, where children can add their own designs to a real car! According to Imagine That, visitors to its Water Area should be advised that 'there's a good chance you'll get wet and an outside chance you'll get soaked!' The Imagination Village contains shops and restaurants.

Knowsley Safari has been welcoming visitors since 1971! Its 5 mile Safari Drive is the longest in the UK and home to many animals from around the world including lions, wildebeest, camels and bison. Families can also discover the Safari via the Baboon Bus or Foot Safari where Amur Tigers, tapir, capybara, meerkats and giraffe can all be spotted. In addition, the popular Flight of the Talons bird of prey display takes place daily where guests can experience vultures, hawks and stalks feeding, flying and swooping just inches above their heads.

Offering a large range of Animal Experiences that must be pre-booked, including getting up close to a giraffe or feeding a lion it's breakfast, these experiences are just the adventure you're looking for! Getting children to eat can sometimes be tricky, but food can also provide a lot of fun too! At Gusto, Albert Dock, children (complete with chef's hat) can make their own pizza and then devour their creations.
