Grévin Museum

For more than a century, the Grévin museum has grown to now hold more than 3,000 wax models. With its reproductions of historical characters (Louis XIV, Mozart, etc.) and current celebrities (Kylian Mbappé, Lady Gaga, etc.), the Grévin Museum is a 3-dimensional history book and a window onto topical issues. There is also a space especially made for children. It enables even the youngest visitors to see their favourite characters: Scrat from Ice Age, Obelix and even Spiderman as well as cartoon characters like Titeuf!

Moulin de la Tour

Get ready for a journey back through time with a visit to this authentic Parisian windmill, which has been fully restored and listed as a 'Monument Historique' since 1979. This medieval construction is typical of the stone windmills of the era with storeys that decrease in size as you go up. Inside, you can see the full grain grinding machinery and many detailed documents.

The work ended in 1991 when the milling mechanism and the system used to turn the mill to face the wind was finished being installed.



Aquarium of Paris

Located in the heart of Paris, in the Trocadero gardens, the Aquarium of Paris is one of the most spectacular aquariums in Europe! It houses many species found on French coasts (metropolitan France and overseas territories) including several species of shark. You will have the opportunity to take part in a vast number of activities, such as feeding the sharks, meeting a diver, touching the fish, etc. There are also 2 cinema screens, the fun Ciné Ludique and the science-based Ciné Sciences as well as themed exhibitions, educational activities and creative workshops.

Jardin d'Acclimatation

The Jardin d'Acclimatation was designed by Emperor Napoleon III. It is the capital city's only amusement park and the first of its kind in the country. Opened in 1860 and fully renovated in 2018, it welcomes nearly 2 million visitors to its 42 attractions and 18 hectares of gardens. Within the unique historical surroundings of the Jardin d'Acclimatation, which draws in both locals and tourists from across the world, lies a modern amusement park as well as twelve restaurants and food trucks, lawns for relaxing picnics as well as a farm and an aviary housing 400 animals and birds!
