The gorgeous gardens at the Palais des Papes haven't always been associated with peaceful strolls. In the past, a succession of popes exhibited a real menagerie of exotic beasts here! As a display of wealth and prestige, bears, lions, camels, wild boars, deer and wild cats were on show...thankfully in cages!

This UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of Avignon's most iconic sights, needs no introduction. As you visit the twenty-five rooms, you will get a behind-the-scenes look at its construction, its cultural influence and the power yielded by the succession of popes who lived there. Admire the sumptuous frescoes and decorations painted by Italian artist Matteo Giovannetti as well as the three papal gardens.

Requien Museum

This former cabinet of curiosities was assembled by the naturalist Esprit Requien. Its inestimable value can perhaps be best expressed in numbers: the Requien Museum features a million specimens gathered from all over the world and houses the fifth largest herbarium in France (137 metres long!). The collections (zoology and palaeontology, among others) in this renowned research centre are studied by experts from around the world. The exhibitions draw visitors into the scientific realm and reward them with countless surprises.
