Did you know?

For lots of people, a trip to Monaco means a visit to the casino... but only for visitors! Since the 19th century, neither the people of Monaco nor members of the princely family have been allowed to try their luck there because the casino was intended to fill the principality's coffers, not bankrupt its people! This also prevents any disputes between croupiers and royalty!

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The Prince's Palace

This iconic Monaco landmark is perched on top of the Rock. A visit to the prince's official residence is your chance to discover the splendour of its State Apartments. You'll see the Throne Room, the Mirror Gallery, the Palace Chapel and its twin spiralling marble staircases, as well as some splendid Italian Renaissance frescoes. Every day at 11.55 am, the carabinieri perform the solemn ceremony of the changing of the guard, a meticulously coordinated spectacle that lasts for seven minutes.

Started by Prince Rainier III in 1950, this wonderful and utterly unique collection of cars is displayed in a sumptuously arranged space stretching over 3,500 m². Here, you can retrace history through the luxurious models on display. Vintage vehicles epitomising bygone eras sit alongside racing cars that have left their mark on the Monte Carlo Rally and the F1 Monaco Grand Prix.

Princesse Antoinette Park is a little green oasis in the heart of the city. Visitors can recharge their batteries in the 'zen area' or take a stroll among the ancient olive trees before heading on to the mini farm to see the goats, ducks, hens and rabbits, or the vegetable garden. There are also lots of fun, sporting activities on offer too, including a play area, a minigolf course, a kiosk, a range of ball sports, table tennis, badminton and skateboarding.

Larvotto Beach

Just below a promenade that is popular with locals is Monaco's only beach, Larvotto Beach, with its 400 metres of sand, shaded children's area, beach volleyball court and, of course, plenty of restaurants! If you like to stay active, you can try out a wide range of water-based activities, such as standup paddleboarding, pedalos and kayaking, as well as jet skiing and paragliding for an extra dose of adrenaline!
