#### **Museum of Liverpool**

Few cities can match Liverpool for its wealth of history. The Museum of Liverpool reflects the city's global significance through its unique geography, history and culture. Visitors can explore how the port, its people and their creative and sporting history have shaped the city. The museum opened on 19th July 2011 in a landmark building on the waterfront and has won several awards, including the Council of Europe Museum Prize in 2013. Its collections cover Social History, the Overhead Railway, which closed 60 years ago and, of course, The Beatles. There really is something for all the family at this fascinating venue.
