For lots of people, a trip to Monaco means a visit to the casino... but only for visitors! Since the 19th century, neither the people of Monaco nor members of the princely family have been allowed to try their luck there because the casino was intended to fill the principality's coffers, not bankrupt its people! This also prevents any disputes between croupiers and royalty!



The Prince's Palace

This iconic Monaco landmark is perched on top of the Rock. A visit to the prince's official residence is your chance to discover the splendour of its State Apartments. You'll see the Throne Room, the Mirror Gallery, the Palace Chapel and its twin spiralling marble staircases, as well as some splendid Italian Renaissance frescoes. Every day at 11.55 am, the Carabiniers perform the solemn ceremony of the changing of the guard, a meticulously coordinated spectacle that lasts for seven minutes.

It includes a football stadium with 18,525 seats, an athletics track, a sports hall and a water-sports centre.


